## Senior Executive Group chooses leader

The Greater Philadelphia Senior Executive Group board of directors has named Dwayne Patterson of North Hanover chairman and CEO for a one-year term. He succeeds Roy Hibberd, who took the chairman's position in late 2009 following the death of executive group founder Constantine Pavlides. Hibberd, who is a senior vice president, corporate secretary and general counsel for Dollar Financial Group in Berwyn, Pa., will remain on the board of directors.

Patterson is vice president of Townsend Machine, a Chesterfield company that manufactures parts and assemblies for the aerospace, water treatment and petroleum industries. Patterson was formerly the chairman of the executive group's membership committee, overseeing its growth from 200 members in 2004 to more than 1,350 today.
